
## Port based VLAN setup


Topology:

PC-----L2 switch---- (port7 VLAN2) 860E (port8 VLAN3)-----L2 switch-----PC


Setup:

(1) Add new VLAN interface. We need to assign virtual network range to these VLAN.







(2) Go to interface > switch management. You need to assign each VLAN to correct LAN port.




(3) Add new interface group for VLAN2 and VLAN3.




(4) Because VLAN interface IP is a virtual IP address. Therefore we need to add this IP address in the ARP table.





(5) Because VLAN interface IP is a virtual IP address. Therefore we need to add this IP address in the main table, then we can ping this IP address from PC.



(6) Add new IP rules. #3 is for any traffic routed from one VLAN to other VLAN. For example, from VLAN 2 to VLAN3.
