- 1. **Open** Control Panel in your PC/Notebook.
- 2. Click on Programs.
- 3. Click on Turn Windows features on or off link.
- 4. Expand the SMB 1.0/CIFS File Sharing Support option.
- 5. Tick the **SMB** 1.0/CIFS Client option.
- 6. Click the OK button.

How to enable Storage on DSL-G2562DG

- 1. Login to the Router using 10.0.0.2 and login with your default username and password.
- 2. Plug in your Storage Device to the Router.
- 3. Go to Applications \rightarrow Storage Services \rightarrow Samba Server \rightarrow Click Enable and Apply.
