

# How to install Realtek installer package on BigSur MacOS11.0+

This paragraph is written to make a quick guide through the steps of installing realtek installer package on MacOS11.0+.

## 1. Disable SIP

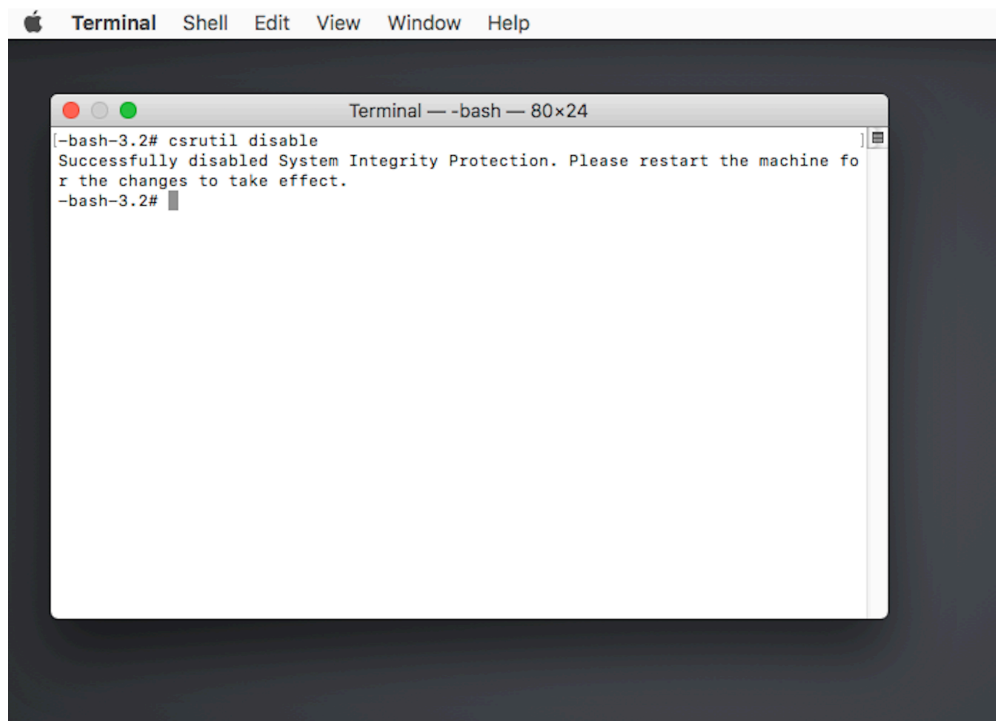
Before installing driver package(Install.pkg), SIP need to be disabled while rebooting.

- a. Boot macOS into Recovery Mode: press cmd+R while rebooting until the Apple icon was shown
- b. Select Utilities > Terminal



- c. After opening Terminal, type the following command and press enter

"csrutil disable"



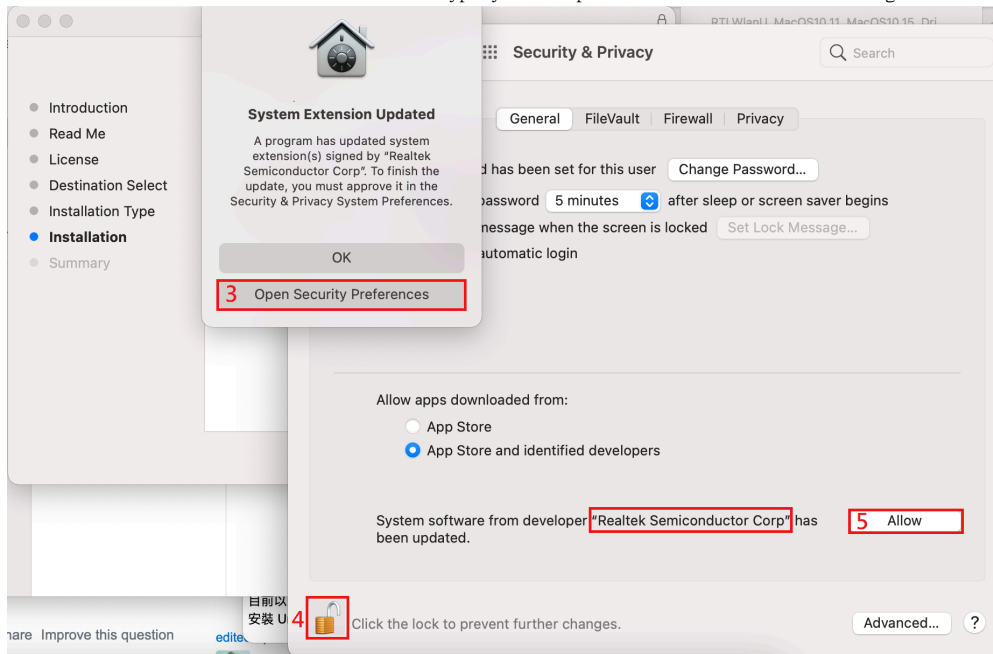
- d. Reboot to apply the change

## 2. Double click Install.pkg to start installing process and System Extension message window will pop up

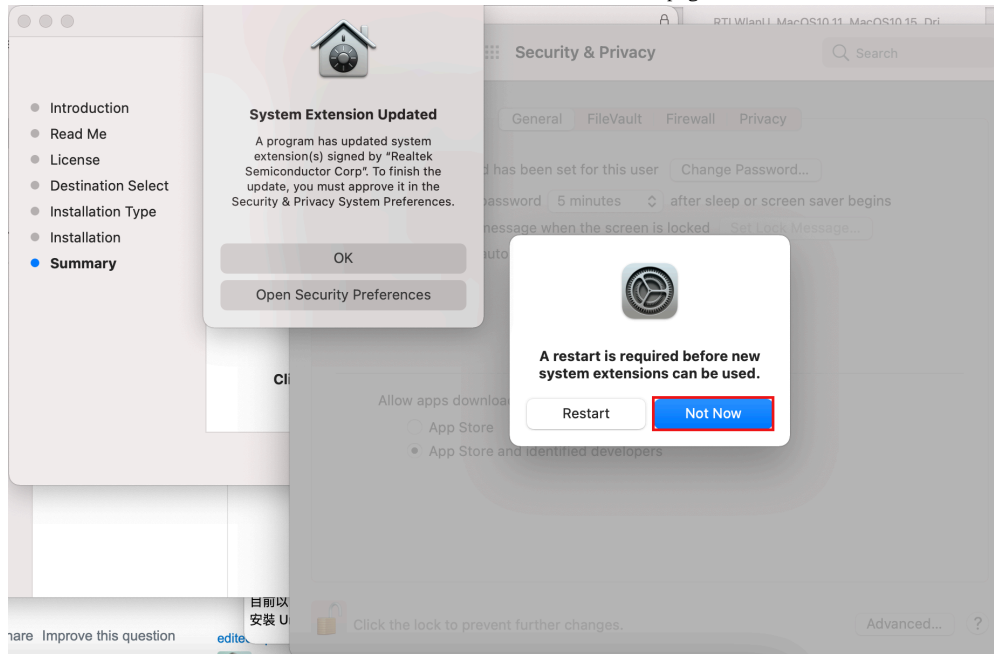


Install.pkg

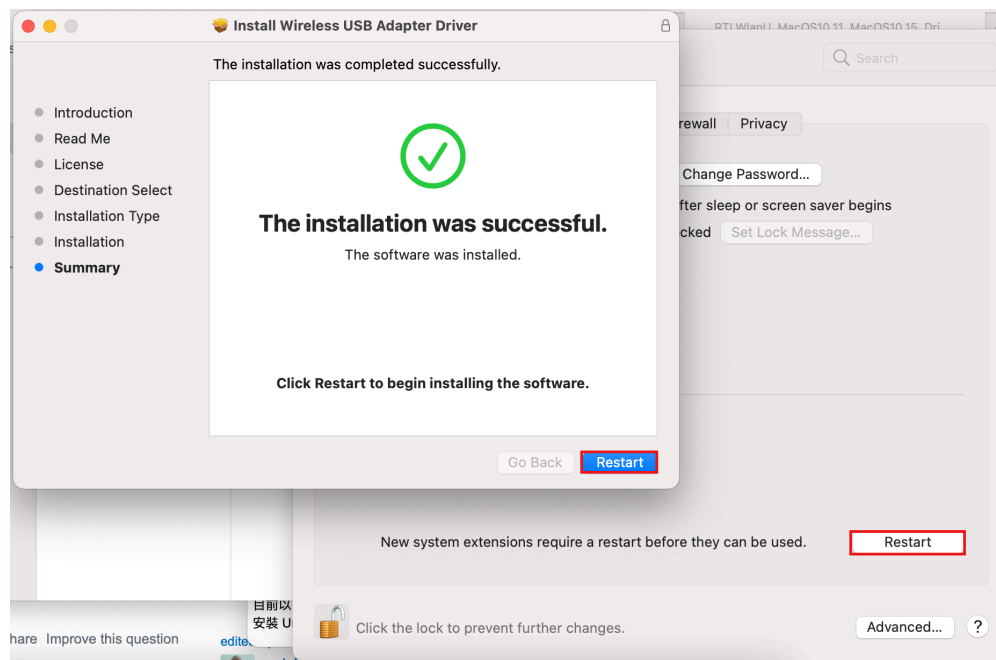
- Click the "Open Security Preferences" button and the Security & Privacy setting window will pop up
- Press the "Lock icon" on the down left and type your PC password to make further change



- Press the "Allow" button and the confirmation message window will pop up
- Press "Not Now" button and wait until installation of Install.pkg finished



- After installation, restart to apply the system extension change  
💡 Since all install operations require a reboot after MacOS10.14+, reboot is necessary.



**i** The installation may be failed due to System Extension Block of Apple security policy. Any System Extension change requires a restart to apply changes. If the installation failed result was shown, do not panic and restart in Recovery mode and disable SIP, and then install Install.pkg again.

8. **Restart shall always be rebooted in Recovery mode and disable SIP** for installing Install.pkg
9. After reboot, the realtek wlan adapter works properly
