

[Basic Manual Setup for DWR-957X- How to configure samba storage]

Step 1: Open your web browser and type **10.0.0.2** into the address bar, then press Enter.



If your device is connected to the router, it will take you to a blue D-Link page asking for a username and password. Default Username is admin, password is admin, unless it was updated.



Step 2: Once logged in, navigate to

Applications → Storage Service → Samba Server



Step 3: Please make sure that the storage device is connected and that Enable Samba Service is ticked

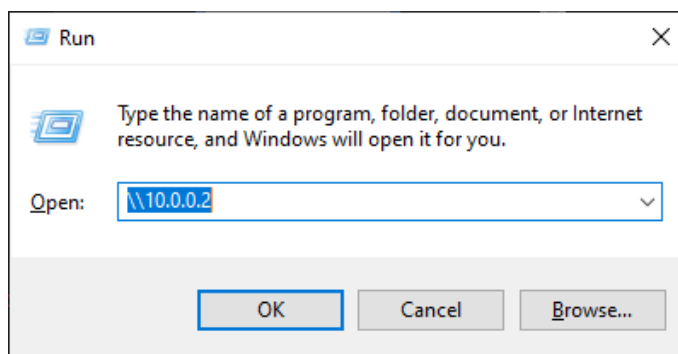

Step 4: To make sure that the Storage Device is picking up navigate to

Applications → Storage Service → Storage Device info

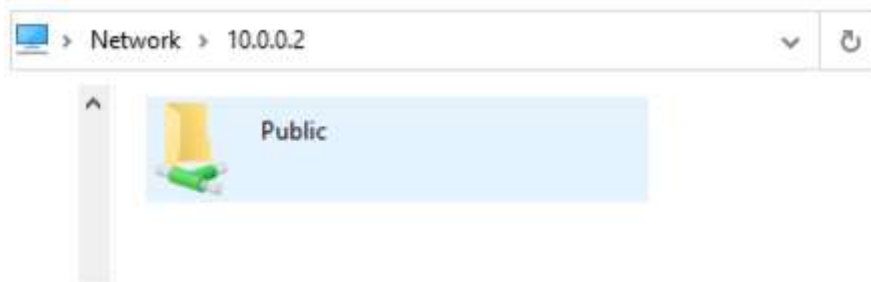


Step 5: Open the “Run Command” Prompt by pressing the Windows Key + R, the following will appear.



Type in the Routers Default IP address and click OK for example: \\10.0.0.2 to access the shared storage connected to the Router.

Step 6: This page will Appear Next



Step 7: Click on the Folder that is shown, it will ask you to enter a Username and password, this will be the Routers Details in which you access it via the 10.0.0.2 address.



Step 8: Once the Details have been entered you will be able to access the shared Media on your storage device as seen below
